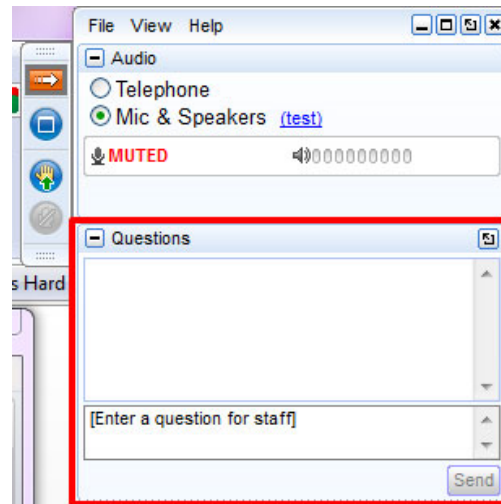

# I need to remotely access my work computer





- Your computer is still in the office and you have limited to no access to it remotely
- Have important documents only accessible on your work computer
- Need to use applications only installed on your work computer
- Want to use your work computer just like you're in the office



# Solution: Remote Access – Quick Start

- Remote access agent installed on your work computer
- Wipfli provides communication and how-to guides for your employees
- You login to a web portal from your home computer or laptop
- Login with your same username and password
- Securely access your computer just like you're sitting at your desk

## Peer to peer chat

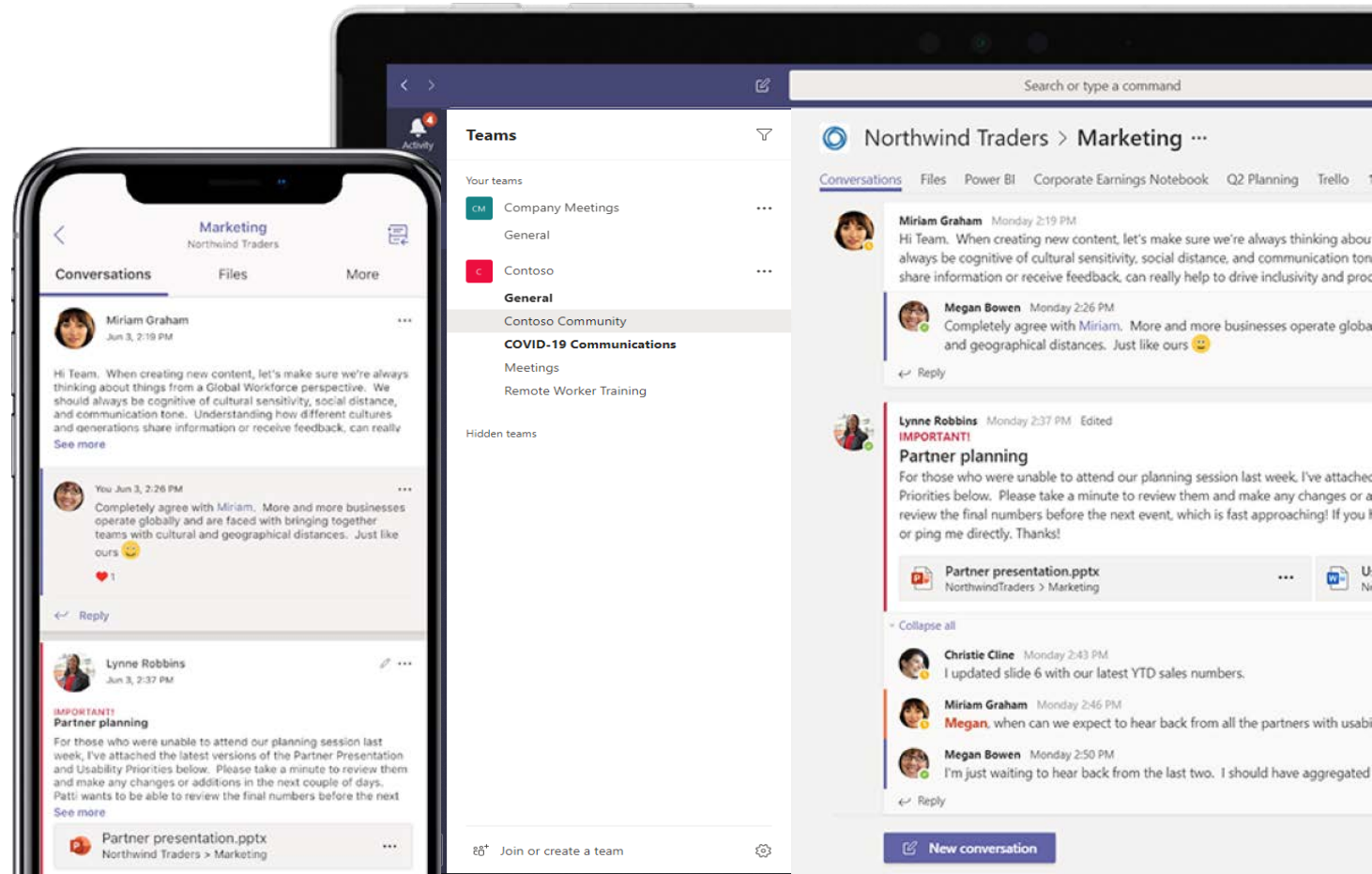
1:1 chats and conversations on any device centered around the way you work

## Voice and video calls

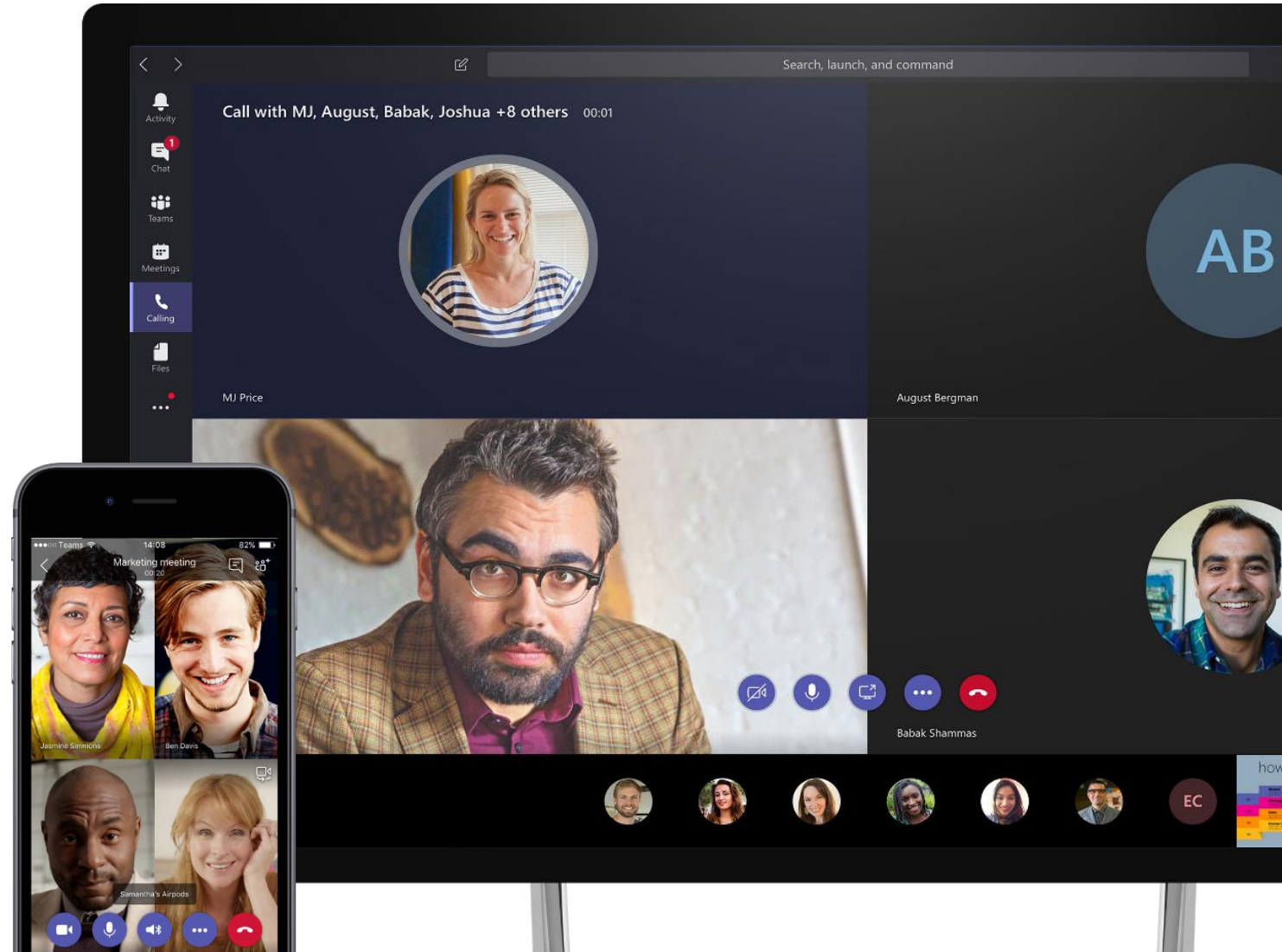
1:1 or group voice and video calls to Teams users in your organization without needing a phone line

## Online meetings

Use your device's built-in audio and video or upgrade to a Teams certified headset or speakerphone

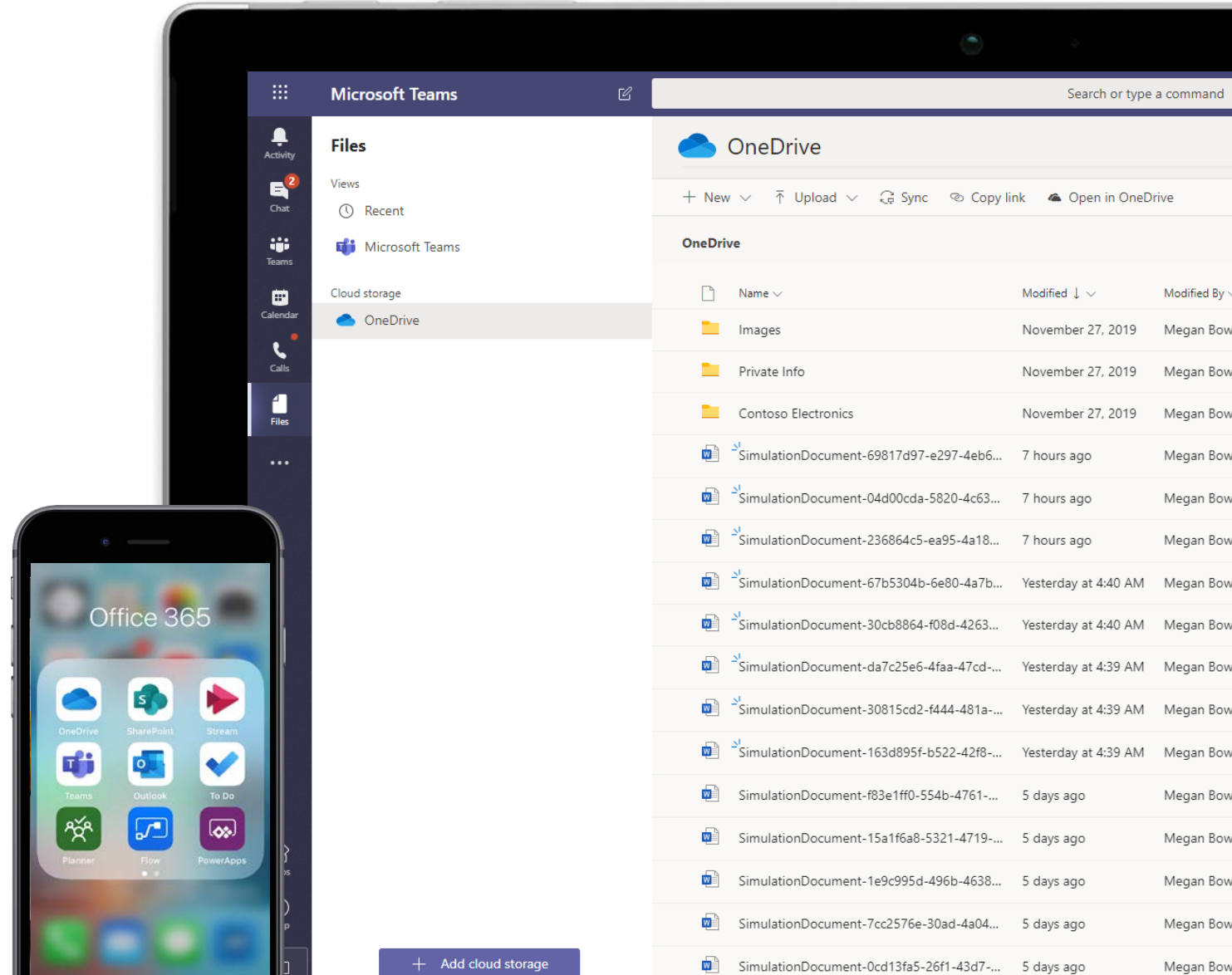

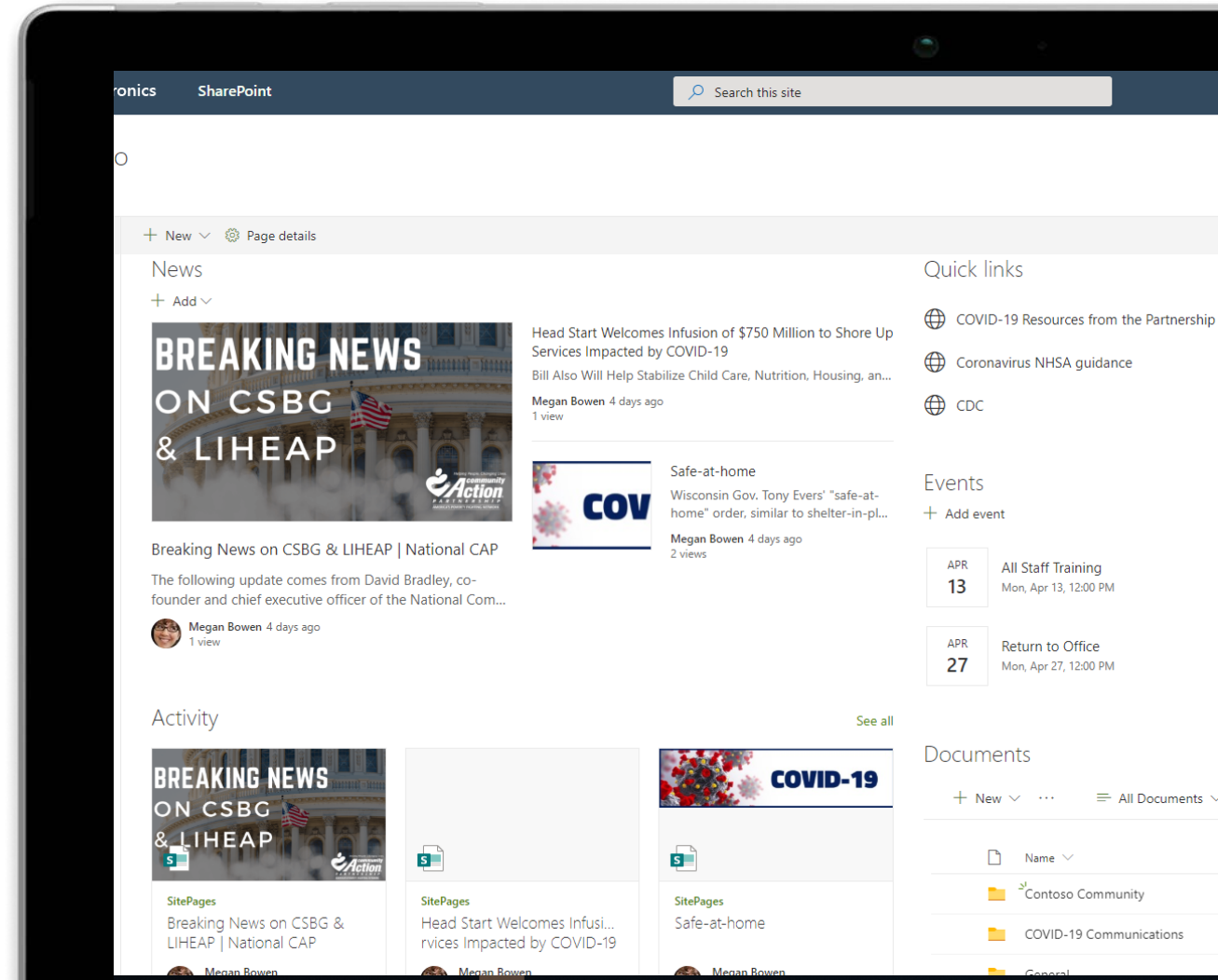
